## Slide 1: What is interlibrary loan and when would you use it?

Slide 2: Have you ever discovered the perfect book or journal article for your research topic, only to find out that OU Libraries does not own a copy of it? No problem, request that book or journal article through the library's Interlibrary Loan Service.

Slide 3: The OU Libraries' Interlibrary Loan team can get books, articles, and other materials from libraries all over the world.

Slide 4: While doing your research, look for the link that says "Request item via Interlibrary Loan." This link will connect you to an automated form to request those items not owned by OU Libraries.

Slide 5: You can also submit interlibrary loan request forms by clicking on the "My ILL /Sooner Xpress" link in the Quick Links section of the OU Libraries homepage.

Slide 6: On the My ILL page, select the appropriate request form located under New ILL Request.

Slide 7: Don't let "no full text available" stop your research! Use interlibrary loan!
