John Alley Collection

Alley, John. Papers, 1890–1940. 2.50 feet.

University professor. A letter (1912) to Alley from Victor M. Locke, Jr., principal chief of the Choctaws, listing present and former principal chiefs of the Five Civilized Tribes, and discussing the status of the Choctaw government; a four-page manuscript (n.d.) entitled "For the First Time: The True Story of the Last Oklahoma Indian Uprising as Told by the Man Who Put It Down," as related to Alley by Col. Roy V. Hoffman of the Oklahoma National Guard; Hoffman's official reports (1909) concerning the Crazy Snake Rebellion, along with Governor Charles N. Haskell's orders (1909); correspondence (1926–1942) concerning Kingfisher College; documents (n.d.) about the Dalton family; and miscellaneous research notes and professional correspondence (1920–1942) accumulated by Alley as a professor of government.

John Alley was a professor of Government at the University of Oklahoma during the 1920s and 1930s. He was a graduate of Harvard and served in the military during World War I. After the war he continued to be active with the National Guard. Professor Alley's collection consists generally of correspondence, research notes, manuscripts, and other papers related to his work and research.

This collection retains, for the most part, the original order and organization of Professor Alley's original files. The first portion of the collection consists of the Professor's correspondence. These letters are arranged in alphabetical order. They are then arranged in chronological order for each separate individual.

The second section of the collection is comprised of subject files arranged in alphabetical order. The majority of these files were created by Alley, with only minor modification and subject expansion occurring during the creation and organization of the collection.

Included in the subject files section are letters, manuscripts, and documents which exhibit Professor Alley's interest in military, Indian, and western history. These include letters from Victor M. Locke, Jr., Principal Chief of Choctaw Nation; a four page manuscript relative to the Crazy Snake Rebellion of 1909; a manuscript by U.S. Marshal George Tucker relating his frontier experiences; letters and documents concerning Kingfisher College and a few documents about the Dalton family.
