Dr. Leila Edna Andrews Collection

Andrews, Leila Edna (1876-1954). Papers, 1894-1954. .10 feet.

Physician. Certificates from Northwestern University (1894, 1899) and the American Medical Association (1907); an application for membership in the D.A.R. (1903); and newspaper clippings regarding Dr. Leila Edna Andrews, who was the first woman elected to the American College of Physicians.

2. Newspaper clipping "Interesting Women . . . Dr. Leila E. Andrews" with a brief biographical sketch (Oklahoma City, c. 1930s.).

4. Pioneer Telephone and Telegraph Company Exchange Contract, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory (1907).
5. Application for membership in the Daughters of the American Revolution, filled out by Dr. Andrews (1903).
6. American Medical Association Membership Certificate #16457, issued to Leila E. Andrews, MD (1907).
