Frank C. Carter Collection

Carter, Frank C. (1862–1954). Papers, 1930–1956. 1 foot.

Politician. Correspondence (1938–1956) regarding farm mortgages, Carter's campaigns and election as state auditor in 1938 and as Oklahoma secretary of state in 1942, his retirement from political office in 1946, and his death in 1954; a scrapbook (1930–1948) of clippings and correspondence about Carter's political career; and a certificate (n.d.) from the Oklahoma Sheriffs and Peace Officers Association, honoring him for a lifetime of service to Oklahoma law enforcement.
