## Faust, Robert L. Architectural drawings, 1952-1956. 12 cubic feet.

Architect. Architectural drawings (1952-1956) created by Robert L. Faust as a student of Bruce Goff at the University of Oklahoma School of Architecture. The drawings depict a forestry fire control station, a gas station, an airport for Oklahoma City, a motel, and other structures. Faust's projects completed for Goff's aesthetic course illustrate various design concepts and their practical application. Many of the drawings are on board, or cased in original board frames.

## Series 1. Sophomore Year Architectural Drawings, 1952-1953

This series contains architectural drawings by Robert L. Faust as a student at the University of Oklahoma's School of Architecture during his sophomore year. The drawings depict a forestry fire control station and a pedestrian overpass.

### Series 2. Third Year Architectural Drawings, 1954

This series contains architectural drawings by Robert L. Faust as a student at the University of Oklahoma's School of Architecture during his third year. The drawings depict a gas station and an Oklahoma City airport. The airport works are drawn in unfixed pencil on the reverse (textured) side of frosted acetate and will smudge if touched.

### Series 3. Fourth Year Architectural Drawings, 1954-1955

This series contains architectural drawings by Robert L. Faust as a student at the University of Oklahoma's School of Architecture during his fourth year. They include assignments from ARCH 273 Bruce Goff's aesthetic course, and ARCH 274 showing the application of the ARCH 273 work depicting a drug store, an international book exhibit, a theater, and an art museum for Chicago.

### Series 4. Fifth Year Architectural Drawings, 1955-1956

This series contains architectural drawings by Robert L. Faust as a student at the University of Oklahoma's School of Architecture during his fifth year. The drawings depict a gas station, a restaurant, and a motel.
