Wirt Franklin Papers

Franklin, Wirt (1883-1962). Papers, 1903-1990. 64 cubic feet.

Attorney and oilman. Correspondence (1927-1962), business and general files (1903-1990), and financial records (1904-1974) of Wirt Franklin, a longtime citizen of Ardmore, Oklahoma, who was key in developing the Healdton Field. His papers span nearly the length of his six-decade career as an attorney and oilman. Among them are the records of Apple & Franklin, his law practice with Samuel Apple, which represented citizens of the Choctaw and Chickasaw nations in citizenship claims, land ownership issues, and guardianship cases in the early 20th century. The largest portion of the collection consists of the business and financial files of his many companies and partnerships, including the Crystal Oil Company, Wirtaine Petroleum Corporation, Ardmore Investment Company, Franklin, Aston & Fair, and others. The collection also documents his work as a Special Field Assistant for the U.S. Petroleum Administration for War, as well as his activities with the American Petroleum Institute, the Independent Petroleum Association of America, and the Mid-Continent Oil & Gas Association.

Biographical Note

Wirt Franklin was born in Richmond, Missouri on March 22, 1883 to Irene Hudgins Franklin and John H. Franklin. He grew up in Kansas, Washington D.C., and Illinois, graduating from high school in Lacon, Illinois, in 1900. He moved to Muskogee, Indian Territory, to work for the Dawes Commission from 1902-1905, enrolling tribal members in the Choctaw and Chickasaw nations. He attended law school at Columbian University (now George Washington University). He passed the bar examination in 1906 and was admitted to practice before the U.S. Court for the Southern District in 1907. He formed a law partnership with Samuel A. Apple (known as Apple & Franklin) which lasted until 1913. The same year he began development in the Healdton oil field along with Samuel A. Apple, Roy M. Johnson, Edward Galt, and A.T. McGhee, and founded Crystal Oil Company. He left Crystal Oil Company in 1916 to work as an independent oilman, eventually founding Wirt Franklin Petroleum Company in 1927. He helped to organize the Independent Petroleum Association of America and was its first president from 1929-1935. In 1930 he lobbied Congress and testified before the U.S. House Ways and Means Committee to for passage of a tariff protecting independent oil producers from global suppliers. In 1932 he ran unsuccessfully as a Republican candidate for the U.S. Senate. During World War II, he served as a special field assistant for the U.S. Petroleum Administration for War. Franklin was married three times. His first marriage, to Mary Cecile Collyer in 1902, produced two children, Chester and Priscilla, but ended in divorce in 1922. He wed a widow, Virginia B. Douthitt (née Doss), in 1923. She brought her daughter, Louise Douthitt, and a niece, Jewell Doss, to the marriage, and they were adopted by Wirt Franklin. They also adopted another child, Betty Jean, in 1928. Virginia died in 1937. His third wife was Anna Witherspoon, whom he married in 1939. Wirt Franklin died at age 79 in Dallas, Texas, on September 24, 1962.

Collection Series

Series 1: 1927-1962. This series primarily contains the correspondence files of Wirt Franklin. It is divided into six subseries with the Wirt Franklin correspondence files being the most extensive and comprehensive. The remaining subseries are correspondence files and printed materials from Franklin's work for various organizations: Wirt Franklin Petroleum Corporation, American Petroleum Institute, Independent Petroleum Association of America, Mid-Continent Oil & Gas Association, and Petroleum

Administration for War / Petroleum Industry War Council. Each subseries is roughly in Franklin's original order, arranged alphabetically and chronologically. The files include business and personal letters, printed materials, and correspondence files of Robert Rhys "Rees" Evans, an Ardmore, Oklahoma, attorney who was Franklin's longtime business associate.

Series 2: Business Files, 1903-1979. This series is a general grouping of Wirt Franklin's professional business files, and is divided into three subseries: Numbered Legal Jackets; General Legal, Real Estate, and Business Files; and Petroleum Industry Files. The Numbered Legal Jackets subseries contains the papers that Franklin kept folded in legal jackets, each bearing a file number at the top edge of the jacket. This subseries was reassembled in file number order, is incomplete, and multiple indexes to the files are present in the collection. The papers in the legal jackets are related to other documents throughout the collection. The General Legal, Real Estate, and Business Files contain the files of Apple & Franklin attorneys, various real estate records for lands owned or managed by Franklin or the Ardmore Investment Company, and records of other businesses operated by Franklin. The Petroleum Industry Files contain extensive records of Franklin's petroleum industry companies such as Crystal Oil, Desada, Ruby, Wirtaine, Cromwell-Franklin, and others. The files have a variety of records including financial spreadsheets, correspondence, legal papers, newspaper clippings, and maps.

Series 3: General Files, 1914-1990. This series contains Wirt Franklin's personal, political, and agricultural files. The personal files cover his membership in Ardmore church and civic groups, and contain personal files related to his medical health, the adoption of children, and wills of family members. The Politics subseries documents his involvement with the Oklahoma Republican Party and his 1932 campaign for the U.S. Senate. The Farming and Livestock subseries is comprised of his farm and cattle herd management records, as well as the poultry-related files of his associate, Robert Rhys "Rees" Evans.

Series 4: Financial Records, 1904-1974. This series contains the accounting, tax, estate, insurance, and banking records of Wirt Franklin, his family members, and his companies. The arrangement within each subseries is largely chronological. The tax materials include reports for Franklin and his companies, and tax receipts for county taxes paid on real estate holdings. The Estate and Inheritance Files contain materials related to Wirt Franklin's estate as well as the estates of his first two wives, Mary Cecile

(Collyer) Cates, and Virginia B. Franklin. The bank records include cancelled vouchers, checks, and receipts from multiple banks. Most of the banking records remain folded and stapled together.
