Anna Laura Brisky Hertzog Collection

Hertzog, Anna Laura Brisky (1873–1963). Papers, 1904–1948. 2 items.

Educator and civic leader. A combination account book, scrapbook, and family diary (1904–1948) which includes descriptions of the mining boom in the Wichita Mountains and early school board meetings in Comanche County, Oklahoma, along with a manuscript (n.d.) entitled “Pioneer Days in Comanche Co.”

Biography:

Mrs. Anna Briskey Hertzog, wife of William Hertzog, who settled and proved up on a claim on the Kiowa, Comanche and Apache Reservation in 1901, was a pioneer school teacher and civic leader.

Item:

1. A letter giving a brief account of pioneer days in Comanche County, Oklahoma
2. Scrapbook containing newspaper clippings, recipes, poems, pictures, cartoons and penciled notes which relate to local and national affairs.
