**Hines, M. D. Papers, 1858–1942. .10 foot.**

Businessman. Financial agreements and correspondence (1858–1942) relating to family affairs and Hines's farm, cattle ranch, and nursery near Maysville, Arkansas. One letter (1868) describes preparations for a cattle drive from Boggy Depot, Indian Territory, to Maysville, Arkansas.
