Henry Sessler Hoss Collection

Hoss, Henry Sessler (ca. 1882–1921). Papers, 1898–1931. .10 foot.

Physician. An account book (1917); notes (1904) from a course of lectures on obstetrics; two letters (1898, n.d.); and obituaries of Hoss, who practiced medicine in Muskogee, Oklahoma, from 1906 to 1921. The collection includes an appointment book (1931) of A. R. Gregory.

Folder:

1. Two letters to Dr. Hoss, one from J.E.M. (February 6, ----) and one from Clarence B. Wallace (March 28, 1898).
2. Obituaries on Dr. Hoss (1922); two prescriptions written by Dr. A.L. Gregory (1930s); Oklahoma private auto registration certificate (1918); certificates and passes for free shipping and travel for several railway lines. Dr. Hoss was the Chief Surgeon of the Midland Valley Railroad.
3. Lecture notes from an obstetrics class (1904).
4. Appointment book for 1931, belonging to Dr. A.L. Gregory.
5. Patient account ledger for 1917.
