Mary Prosser Jayne Collection

Jayne, Mary Prosser. Papers, 1896–1924. .33 foot.

Missionary. Correspondence (1915) and pamphlets (1924) of missionary Robert Hamilton, stationed in Shawnee, Oklahoma, regarding his work there; and manuscript notes (n.d.) by Jayne, regarding missionary work at the Cheyenne and Arapaho Indian Baptist Mission and the class of 1896 of the Baptist Missionary Training School.

1. "Rules for the Class Letter. Class of 1896. Baptist Missionary Training School". Jayne was the Correspondence Secretary; notice of business meeting of the Baptist Church, with intended items of business listed (March 17, 1924); letter from Grace Clifford to Rev. Robert Hamilton with names of Chilocco students who were not included when letters of admission were sent out, June 18, 1912; business report on Cheyenne and Arapaho Indian Baptist Mission stationery (no date, and very brief).
2. Several empty envelopes originally containing business correspondence, 1910-1920; a receipt for a donation to the "75 Million Fund," July 31, 1924.
3. Two certificates of baptism into the Baptist Church, one for Butler Fields, May 8, 1921, and one for Marion Bourassa, April 16, 1922; a "report card" for Louisa Hauser from Haskell Institute in Lawrence, Kansas, January 1910; a "black letter" announcing the death of Ellen Black Hawk, April 1931.
4. Two personal letters written to Jayne, and three empty envelopes, 1910-1916.
