**John, Walter N. Records, 1894–1949. .10 foot.**

Physician. Ledgers (1923–1938) in which John recorded patient visits and services rendered; a diploma (1894) issued to John; and a biography and news clippings (1894–1949) regarding his life and career.

1. *The Southeast Oklahoman* (Hugo, Oklahoma) -- October 21, 1954: "Former Hugo Doctor Lauded in Newspaper Story in American (*Antlers (Oklahoma) American*)", with a brief biographical sketch about Dr. John.
2. A manuscript by Miss Hattie relating how Dr. John came to Indian Territory (no date).
3. Letter from Mrs. L. Williams to Mrs. John, with the \$4.00 she owed Dr. John (December 30, 1949).
4. "Payment on Old Debt", a newspaper article about the letter described above (no date). Two copies.
5. "Nelson Village is Cited as Thriving Commercial and Social Center Before Turn of Century, Recalls Prankster" by Mrs. George Mansell. This article contains anecdotes about Dr. John (no date).
6. "New, Modern Office Building of Dr. W.N. John, 203 East Jackson", a newspaper article which also contains information about Dr. John's career as a physician (March 3, 1935).
7. "Dr. John Purchases New X-Ray Machine" (no date).
8. "Dr. W.N. John, Pioneer Physician, Dies Following Illness of 12 weeks" an obituary containing biographical information about Dr. John. Apparently, his illness was caused by exposure to X-ray machines (no date).
9. Account book for 1923.
10. Financial records for 1938.
