Editor. Edited manuscripts of "Travels in North America, 1822–1824," by Paul Wilhelm, Duke of Württemberg, and "Life of George Bent," by George E. Hyde; articles (1964–1977) by Lottinville on George Milburn, the University of Oklahoma seal, and the Rhodes Legal History Collection; a letter (1966) from E. N. Roberts to R. L. Disney, relating the meeting in 1883 of John Roberts with a woman claiming to be Sacajawea; and a notarized statement (1953) of Frank M. Wyncoop concerning the Sand Creek Massacre.
