Massad, Ernest L. (1908–1993). Papers, 1926–1990. 9 feet.

U.S. Army officer. Correspondence and supporting reports and documents (1933–1969) regarding Massad's military service in the U.S. Army, especially his command of the Ninety-fifth Training Division and his service as deputy assistant secretary of defense for reserve affairs. The collection also includes correspondence and related papers (1929–1983) concerning his attendance and athletic career at the University of Oklahoma and his election to the Oklahoma Hall of Fame in 1971.
