Mitchell, Sam W. Papers, 1899–1939. 7 items.

Mine worker. Contracts (1903–1939); a permit (1902); and leases (1899), all relating to the coal industry near McAlester, Oklahoma; plus a “Coal Mine Workmen’s Compensation and Employers Liability Policy” (1922).

Biographical Note:

S.W. Mitchell was born in Savannah, Indian Territory, and came to Hartshorne, Indian Territory in 1893.

1. Indian Territory Mining Lease (Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations) Agreement between Napoleon B. Ainsworth and Lemuel C. Burris (Mining trustees of the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations) and the Choctaw, Oklahoma Railroad Company. Length: 6 pp. Feb. 21, 1899.

Permit allowing S.W. Mitchell to reside in the Choctaw Nation as a clerk for one year from Jan. 1, 1902. March 6, 1902.

Agreement made between McAlester Coal Company, Rock Island Coal Company, and Choctaw, Oklahoma and Gulf Railroad Company, Feb. 28, 1903. Includes Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B".

Agreement made between Choctaw, Oklahoma and Gulf Railroad Company and the McAlester Coal Company. Feb. 28, 1903.

2. Agreement made between McAlester Coal Company and Kali Inla Coal Company. May 1, 1903, General Copy Included.

Agreement made between Kali Inla Coal Company and J.T. Jackson, Feb. 19, 1904.

Letter: "Resolutions Passed at Special Meeting of the McAlester Fuel Company. May 12, 1905. Contract By and Between Arkansas and Oklahoma Coal Operators' Association and Independent Coal Operators of Arkansas and Oklahoma and Provisional District No. 21 United Mine Workers of America" In effect from May 8, 1937 to March 31, 1939.
