Edward J. Perkins Papers

Perkins, Edward J. (1928-). Papers, 1928-2007. 89.33 cubic feet.

Diplomat. Papers (1928-2007) of Edward J. Perkins, who served as U.S. Ambassador to Ghana, Liberia, South Africa, the United Nations, and Australia, and served as the Director General of the U.S. Foreign Service. The papers include ambassadorial correspondence (1978-1996), speeches (1980-1992), and subject files (1961-1999). The collection also contains audio and visual recordings (1998-2006), and memorabilia (1979-2006). The materials highlight Ambassador Perkins' years in the Foreign Service, particularly his work to help bring a peaceful end to apartheid in South Africa.

Biographical Note

Edward Joseph Perkins was born in Sterlington, Louisiana, in 1928, to Edward and Tiny Estelle (Noble) Perkins. His parents divorced when he was very young and he was raised by his maternal grandparents on their farm near Haynesville, Louisiana, until his mother remarried and he moved to Portland, Oregon. After graduating from high school, Perkins served for three years in the U.S. Army and an additional four years in the U.S. Marines. He returned to civilian life and worked for the Army and Air Force Exchange in Taipei, Taiwan; Okinawa, Japan; and Bangkok, Thailand, from 1958 to 1972. He earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Maryland, and master's and doctoral degrees from the University Southern California.

In 1978, Perkins entered the U.S. Foreign Service and served in Ghana, twice in Liberia, South Africa, Australia and the United Nations. He also served a two-year term as the Director General of the Foreign Service between 1989 and 1992. One of his greatest achievements was to be one of the major change agents who brought about the peaceful end of apartheid in South Africa. After retiring from the Foreign Service in 1996, Ambassador Perkins came to the University of Oklahoma where he served as the William J. Crowe Chair Professor and Executive Director of the International Programs Center until he retired in 2006.

Perkins authored numerous articles and essays and contributed to several compiled works by other authors. He also wrote his own autobiography, *Mr. Ambassador: Warrior for Peace*, published in 2006.

Over the course of his career, Ambassador Perkins received numerous awards, including the Presidential Distinguished and Meritorious Service Awards; The Department of State's Distinguished Honor and Superior Honor Awards; The Una Chapman Cox Foundation Award for Distinguished Foreign Service Work, and numerous organizational and academic honors. He served on the board of the Cranlana Programme in Melbourne, Australia, was a member of the Board of Trustees for Lewis and Clark College, Portland, Oregon, and the Board of Visitors for the National Defense University, Washington DC. He has also served on the Advisory Board for the Thursday Luncheon Group and the Board of Trustees for the Woodrow Wilson National Fellowship Foundation.

Edward Perkins married Lucy Chen-mei Liu in 1962 and has two daughters. Lucy passed away in 2009.

Collection Series

Series 1: Calendars and Schedules, 1976-2007

This series contains Perkins' calendars and appointment books for the period spanning his professional career, including his service as U.S. Ambassador.

Series 2: Early Life and Education, 1928-1978

This series contains Perkins' genealogical and family history files, some educational records, a copy of his doctoral dissertation, military service records and early employment information.

Series 3: Ambassadorial Papers, 1979-1995

This series is the largest in the collection. It contains Perkins' files from his Foreign Service career. The files are arranged chronologically in the order that he was assigned to each mission.

Series 4: Speeches, 1978-2007

This series contains typescript speeches by Perkins, and by other speakers such as Madeleine Albright, and Warren Christopher.

Series 5: Correspondence, 1978-2007

This series contains both official and personal correspondence of Ambassador Perkins. The bulk of the official correspondence dates from his ambassadorial assignments and is arranged chronologically. The personal correspondence is arranged alphabetically and includes some family letters, and exchanges with world leaders, authors, and other notable personages.

Series 6: Memberships and Affiliations, 1972-2007

This series contains Perkins' files of the many organizations to which he belonged or for which he served on Boards and Advisory Committees. They are arranged in alphabetical order by organization and then chronologically.

Series 7: Subject Files, 1978-2007

This series contains files primarily related to racial relations and cultural history of the United States, South Africa and Australia.

Series 8: Publications, 1987-2007

The bulk of this series contains the manuscript files for Ambassador Perkins' autobiography, *Mr. Ambassador: Warrior for Peace*. Also included are copies of the numerous articles, essays and contributions he made to works compiled by other authors.

Series 9: Audiovisual Media and Photographs, 1957-2007

The Audiovisual Media and Photographs series contains media coverage of foreign policy matters and related events, both professional productions and pieces taped from televised broadcasts. There are also approximately 200 cassette audio taped interviews between Ambassador Perkins and Connie Cronley which were the basis for *Mr. Ambassador: Warrior for Peace*. Transcriptions for the tapes are found in Series 8, Boxes 181-186.

Series 10: Memorabilia and Miscellaneous, 1983-2007

This series contains certificates and plaques awarded to Perkins, posters, memorabilia, and a camel saddle.
