The inscription on the cover reads "For the Library of Cecil Munn from Bertie Bass and Henry B. Bass." A letter in the front cover of the booklet from Cecil Munn to Earl Stone apologizes for the delay in sending him the book and references an enclosed newspaper article, titled "Bob Bass is Killed on Belgian Front," as being the cause of the delay. The letter is dated October 30, 1976.
