Rennie, Albert (1863–1948). Papers, 1900–1951. 14.50 feet.

Attorney. Family and business correspondence (1900–1951); legal documents (1900–1939); and printed material (1900–1951) belonging to Rennie, a Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, attorney. Much of the material relates to real estate transactions, including land allotted to Choctaw and Chickasaw Indians.
