The Fledgling was a collection of prose and poetry, written by UHS 7th and 8th grade classes from 1964 through 1973, and was published annually. Students selected and edited materials, which were prepared throughout the school year. Students typed the material, checked it, designed the artwork (including the cover), and distributed the finished product. Martha Mills, supervisor of junior high English, was the sponsor, and was assisted by Belva Clement and Ruth Fell. Mills donated the copies for the UHS Archives.
