Presidential Papers: John Herbert Hollomon

Biographical Note:

John Herbert Hollomon, born in 1919 and a native of Norfolk, VA, graduated from Augustus Military Academy in Fort Defiance, VA in 1936. He received from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology a B.S. in 1940 and the Ph.D. in metallurgy in 1946.

After a year on the faculty at Harvard, Hollomon served in the U.S. Army from 1942 to 1946 as chief of physical metallurgy at the U.S. Arsenal, Watertown, MA.

In 1946 he joined the General Electric Company Research laboratory as assistant manager of the metallurgical research department. Becoming widely known for his work in the field of metallurgy and rising through the administrative ranks, Hollomon became General Manager of General Engineering Laboratory at Schenectady, NY in 1960. As General Manager, Hollomon was responsible for engineering development work reaching into four major engineering fields: materials engineering, engineering physics and analysis, electrical engineering, and mechanical engineering. While at GE, he was an adjunct professor of metallurgy and served on the science development council of Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI).

In April 1962 Hollomon, appointed by President John F. Kennedy, became the first Assistant Secretary for Science and Technology in the Commerce Department. At Commerce he also served as counsel to, and spokesman for, the Secretary of Commerce on all matters dealing with science and technology. He also sat on the Federal Council for Science and Technology and was a consultant to the President's Science and Advisory Committee. In 1964 he served in advisory positions to four universities: Harvard's visiting committee of the division of engineering and applied physics; Cornell's engineering college council; RPI's science development council; and MIT's educational council. In 1967 he became acting Under-secretary of the Commerce Department and was founder and Chairman of the Commerce Technical Advisory Board.

Hollomon began his tenure with the University of Oklahoma in September 1967 as President-Designate with then President George Lynn Cross. On July 1, 1968 he became the eighth president of the university at the age of 49. On January 13, 1969 he was elected President of the Mid-America State Universities Association.

By the spring of 1969 he and his wife, Margaret, separated and eventually divorced on May 18, 1970. At the University Board of Regents meeting on July 23, 1970 Hollomon read his resignation, naming Pete Kyle McCarter as acting president. Hollomon returned to M.I.T. as a professor. On December 27, 1970 he married Nancy Gade. In 1972 he founded the M.I.T. Center for Policy Alternatives and was its director.

Among the achievements of his short administration were the implementation of the provost system of university administration and the creation of the International Literary Prize awarded by World Literature Today (Books Abroad).
